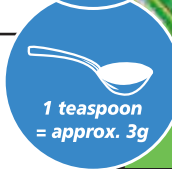

DIRECTIONS

Apply 200g (1 cupful) per square metre. Fork or hoe into the top 5cm of soil, being careful not to damage any surface roots. Keep fertiliser at least 20cm from the stem or trunk of plant. Water well before & after application.

WHEN TO APPLY

Every 6-8 weeks during main growing season (Spring through to Autumn).



POT PLANTS

Sprinkle onto moist potting mix surface (as per chart below). Keep away from trunk or stem of plant. Water well before and after application.

DIRECTIONS

Apply 100g (1/2 cupful) per square metre. Fork or hoe into the top 5cm of soil, being careful not to damage any roots. Keep fertiliser away from trunks or stems of plant. Water well before & after application.

WHEN TO APPLY

Every 6-8 weeks during main growing season (Spring through to Autumn).

POT PLANTS

Sprinkle onto moist potting mix surface (as per chart below). Keep away from trunk or stem of plant. Water well before and after application.

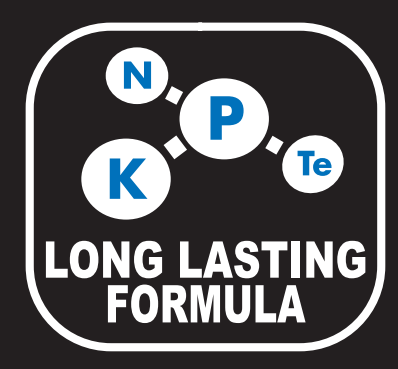
